MAKING AN APPROPRIATION TO THE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION FOR A PEDESTRIAN
WALKWAY NEAR KAYENTA.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona:

2 Section 1. Appropriation; purpose; exemption

3 A. The sum of \$400,000 is appropriated from the state general fund in
4 fiscal year 2001-2002 to the department of transportation for distribution to
5 the Navajo Nation for an additional pedestrian dedicated walkway across
6 Laguna Wash Bridge on state highway 163 near Kayenta for the safety of
7 students and other pedestrian traffic.

8 B. The appropriation made in subsection A of this section is exempt
9 from the provisions of section 35-190, Arizona Revised Statutes, relating to
10 lapsing of appropriations.
