19	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:
20	Section 1. (a) There is created the Birmingham
21	Business Council to evaluate, research, and recruit businesses
22	for the City of Birmingham. The council shall consist of the
23	following:
24	(1) Two members of the Jefferson County House of
25	Representatives Delegation whose districts lie entirely within
26	the City of Birmingham appointed by a majority vote of the
27	members of the House Delegation.

1 (2) Two members of the Jefferson County Senate
2 Delegation whose districts lie entirely within the City of
3 Birmingham appointed by a majority vote of the members of the
4 Senate Delegation.

- (3) One member who is a resident of the City of Birmingham appointed by the Mayor of the City of Birmingham.
- (4) A member of the City Council of Birmingham appointed by a majority vote of the city council.
- (5) The Mayor the City of Birmingham or his or her designee.
- (6) Two members appointed by the Birmingham Business Alliance with one appointed member being a member of the African-American Chamber.
- (b) The terms of the legislative members and the Mayor shall be coterminous with their terms of office. The terms of nonlegislative members shall be six-year years.
- (c) The council shall hold its organizational meeting 30 days after the effective date of this act. The council shall meet at the call of the chair or any majority of the members thereof. The council shall have a continuing existence and may meet, act, and conduct its business at any place within the city.

Section 2. The council shall study, review, and make proposals to the Mayor of Birmingham and the city council for the recruitment and retention of businesses within the City of Birmingham.

1 (b) The council may appoint a research director,
2 research assistants, and other personnel necessary to carry
3 out the purposes of this act.

(c) The council may in furtherance of its duties receive annual appropriations from the city council and funds from other sources.

Section 3. (a) The Mayor of the City of Birmingham, the City Clerk, and the City Council of the City of Birmingham shall provide any assistance as may be necessary at the request of the council.

(b) Members of the council shall not be compensated for their service, but may be reimbursed for travel and per deim expenses at the same rate and under the same circumstances as members of the City Council of the City of Birmingham are reimbursed for each day's attendance at a meeting of the council.

Section 4. (a) The council shall report its findings and recommendations to the Mayor of the City of Birmingham, the City Council of Birmingham, and the Jefferson County Legislative Delegation not later than the 10th legislative day of each regular session of the Alabama Legislature beginning with the 2012 Regular Session and at other times deemed necessary by the council.

Section 5. This act shall become effective on the first day of the third month following its passage and approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
