101 CONCERNING THE CRIME OF TRESPASSING IN THE STATE WHILE IN
102 VIOLATION OF FEDERAL IMMIGRATION LAW.

Bill Summary

Makes it a crime for a person who is a citizen of another country to be in the state while in violation of federal immigration law.

4	ANY VIOLATION OF FEDERAL LAW, IT IS UNLAWFUL FOR A PERSON WHO IS
5	A CITIZEN OF ANY COUNTRY OTHER THAN THE UNITED STATES TO ENTER
6	INTO OR BE ON ANY PUBLIC OR PRIVATE LAND IN THIS STATE IF, AT THE
7	TIME OF THE COMMISSION OF THE OFFENSE, THE PERSON IS IN VIOLATION
8	OF THE FEDERAL "IMMIGRATION AND NATIONALITY ACT", 8 U.S.C. SEC.
9	1325, AS AMENDED.
10	(2) (a) A FIRST VIOLATION OF TRESPASSING BY AN ILLEGAL ALIEN
11	IS A MISDEMEANOR AND SHALL BE PUNISHED BY A FINE OF FIVE HUNDRED
12	DOLLARS.
13	(b) A SECOND VIOLATION OF TRESPASSING BY AN ILLEGAL ALIEN
14	IS A CLASS 1 MISDEMEANOR.
15	(c) A THIRD OR SUBSEQUENT VIOLATION OF TRESPASSING BY AN
16	ILLEGAL ALIEN IS A CLASS 4 FELONY.
17	SECTION 2. Effective date - applicability. This act shall take
18	effect upon passage and shall apply to offenses committed on or after said
19	date.
20	SECTION 3. Safety clause. The general assembly hereby finds,
21	determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate
22	preservation of the public peace, health, and safety.
