AN ACT PROMOTING ACCESS TO HIGHER EDUCATION FOR INSTATE STUDENTS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That subdivision (9) of section 10a-29 of the general statutes be
- 2 amended to require any person who is entitled to classification as an
- 3 in-state student for tuition purposes under said subdivision to be
- 4 entitled to tuition waivers, tuition remissions, grants for educational
- 5 expenses and student employment, provided such person
- 6 demonstrates financial need or substantial financial need in accordance
- 7 with section 10a-77, 10a-99 or 10a-105 of the general statutes.

Statement of Purpose:

To promote access to higher education for students in Connecticut.
