"[NEW MATERIAL] NONDISCRIMINATION POLICY FOR ADMISSION TO ANY PUBLIC POST-SECONDARY EDUCATIONAL INSTITUTION--

NONDISCRIMINATION IN ELIGIBILITY FOR EDUCATION BENEFITS. --

- A public post-secondary educational institution A. shall not deny admission to a student on account of the student's immigration status.
- Any tuition rate, scholarship, loan or other post-secondary educational benefit that is granted to residents . 154347. 1
